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The Saskatchewan Organization for Heritage Languages (SOHL) is a provincial non-profit organization. Our mission is to preserve and promote languages in Saskatchewan through educational and cultural programs.

SOHL's Mini-Language Lessons Program provides opportunities for heritage language speakers to teach **8 hours of language and cultural lessons** in Saskatchewan elementary schools, held annually between **October to December** and **January to March**.

Heritage language teachers will receive an **honorarium** from SOHL for each of their lessons (up to 8 hours per classroom).

Applications are now being accepted from volunteer language instructors! Heritage language instructors do not need to be licensed teachers, but they should have experience working with children. Preference will be given those who have formal training or teaching experience.



All language speakers are welcome (other than English and French). Some of the languages that have been taught frequently in the program include:

Arabic, Bengali, Chinese, Cree, German, Hindi, Korean, Russian, Spanish, Tagalog, Ukrainian, Urdu, Yoruba, and many more.
